Areas for Development 2016

Each year, after test results are published for Y1, Y2 and Y6 and assessments are completed for all the other years in school, we look at this, as well as other areas for development in the school for attainment, for teaching, for leadership – including governors, for the curriculum and the fabric of the building. These are the areas we consider priorities:

- Embedding the new national curriculum which was introduced for Y1, Y3 to Y5 in September 2014, Y2 & Y6 in September 2015
- Continue to develop the new Computing curriculum
- New assessment and tracking system, not based on levels
- Raise attainment, especially in more able writers
- Raise the profile of reading in school and at home
- All teachers have a leader role in school, usually in a subject
- Governors have personalised training in important areas like safeguarding, special needs & assessment
- All staff have an understanding of the PREVENT agenda – linked to safeguarding and extremism
- Replacing the roof, replacing heating system
